

Thanks for purchasing the Gold Bokeh Overlay pack from Paper Farms. Feel free to contact me with any questions you may have about this product.

If you are unfamiliar with using non-transparent jpegs as overlays, I provide simple Photoshop instructions below.

Using JPEG overlays:

1. Open the image/photograph that you want to apply the effect to (file > open).
2. Go to file > place embedded and select the overlay that you want. You will see only the jpeg file on top until you change the blending mode as described below.
3. With the overlay layer selected, change the blending mode from "Normal" to "Screen" in the layers panel. You should now see the effect over top of your photo.
4. Move the overlay layer around or resize to get the effect you want.
5. To remove any unwanted bokeh (from over people etc.) use the eraser tool set to "soft".
6. Changing the intensity: to make the effects less intense, simply lower the opacity of the overlay layer on the layers panel. To make the overlays more intense you can duplicate the overlay layer.
