

How edit templates:

Go to the “Layers” panel.

If it's not visible go **Window** -> **Layers**. Or press **F7**


Edit texts via “TEXT” tool. Press “T” to activate tool.

Place your photos into templates

1. Double click smart object icon
2. Place your photo in the just opened window
3. **SAVE using: File/Save** or **ctrl+S** on PC or **cmd+S** on Mac
4. Close the second window

How to get ready to save for Instagram?

1. Find your “Slice” tool which is right under the “Crop” tool.



2. To save 5 pictures together, go to File → Export → Save for Web (or File → Save for Web)

When you're in this menu, select PNG-24 for a good quality. Also you can choose JPEG format



3. Then when you press “Save”. Make sure you have a folder ready that is empty, so you can save these photos into it.

Select Slices – All Slices and that will make sure it saves everything that you made. Then press “Save”.

4. Once it’s done saving you will see that there is a new “images” folder wherever you selected it to save. It has your separate images ready. You just have to delete unnecessary empty slices that appeared due to the spaces between squares in the template, so there are 5 image squares for you to upload to Instagram.
